FIRST ORGANIZATIONAL MEETING FOR THE AEP

Thunder Bay, November 18, 2024. – The AEP (Association for Environmental Protection) held its first organizational meeting in the community of Montcerf-Lytton, last evening.

Ms. Margot Hayden was elected president, and Ms. Léanne Paradis-Mercier was elected secretary-treasurer.

The technical adviser of the meeting was Professor Sidney Allen, chairperson of the Science Department of Lakehead College, who kindly agreed to participate in our cause.

The group of AEP plans to meet monthly on the first Wednesday of each month, in the municipal office of the same community. Its aims are to publicize instances of local pollution and toxic waste dumping, to investigate possible conservation measures in the community, and to recommend publicity to make the community more conservation-oriented.

In commenting on their first meeting, Ms. Hayden and Ms. Paradis-Mercier mentioned that their cause on environmental pollution is very close to their hearts, and that their goal is only to help the community of Montcerf-Lytton to live in a less polluted and healthier environment.
